### One Stem Division Class 1-19

### Division 1 (Single Stem) - Trumpet

Class 1: One Stem Y-Y
Class 2: One Stem W-W

Class 3: One Stem any other colour combinations

### Division 2 (Single Stem) - Large Cup

Class 4: One Stem Y-Y

Class 5: One Stem W-W

Class 6: One Stem any other colour combinations

### Division 3 (Single Stem) - Small Cup

Class 7: One Stem Y-Y
Class 8: One Stem W-W

Class 9: One Stem any other colour combinations

Class 10: One Stem Lincolnshire Lady

### Division 4 (Single Stem), Double Flowers

Class 11: One Double Stem, Perianth White

Class 12: One Double Stem, Perianth Yellow

### **Divisions 5 Triandus (Single Stem)**

Class 13: One Stem, any colour combination

### **Division 6 Cyclamineus**

Class 14: One Stem, any colour combination

### **Division 7 Jonquil (Single Stem)**

Class 15: One Stem, any colour combination

### **Division 8 Tazetta (Single Stem)**

Class 16: One Stem, any colour combination

### **Division 9 Poeticus (Single Stem)**

Class 17: One Stem, any colour combination

### **Division 11 (Split Corona)**

Class 18: One Stem Perianth White

Class 19: One Stem Perianth Yellow

To be displayed in individual test tubes in a three-hole block

### Three Multi Headed Stem Class 20-22

Class 20: Three multi headed stems, any one variety, from division 5.

Class 21: Three multi headed stems, any one variety, from division 7.

Class 22: Three multi headed stems, any one variety, from division 8.

### Three Single Stem Class 23 -25

Class 23: Three single flowered stems from division 1, 2, 3, 4 or 11.

Class 24: Three single flowered stems, any one variety from division 6

Class 25: Three single flowered stems from division 9, 10, 12 and 13

### To be displayed in individual test tubes in a five-hole block

### **Five Stem Class 26**

Class 26: Five single flowered stems from any division

# To be displayed in individual test tubes, five holes plus one block for six distinct stems, five- & three-hole blocks

### **Six Distinct Stems Class 27**

Class 27: Six distinct stems, no more than two stems from any division, three different divisions or more

### **Five Distinct Stems Class 28**

Class 28: Five stems any one variety.

### **Three Distinct Stems Class 29-30**

Class 29: Three distinct stems, one stem from either division 1, 2 or 3

Class 30: Three distinct stems, from division 4

### \*\*Novice Section\*\*

Novice section will include first time exhibitors who have not previously won or been awarded first, second or third prize at a show.

### To be displayed in individual test tubes in a single hole block

### One Stem Division 1 - 4, Class 31 - 35

Class 31: One stem division 1 (two entries each per exhibitor allowed)

Class 32: One stem division 2 (two entries each per exhibitor allowed)

Class 33: One stem division 3 (two entries each per exhibitor allowed)

Class 34: One stem division 4 (two entries each per exhibitor allowed)

Class 35: One stem from any division, up to four entries per exhibitor, but each entry must be from a different division.

# \*\*Youth Section\*\*

Open to any school, society, or group for young people (under 16 years of age)

### Best Five, Single, Art Class & Writing 36-40

- Class 36: Five best daffodils in a vase (one representative entry per class only)
- Class 37: Best single daffodil in a test tube (one representative entry per class only)
- Class 38: Best photographs of daffodils (three representative digital entries per class only)
- Class 39: Best painting of daffodils (three representative entries per class only; A3 or A4)
- Class 40: Best daffodil poem

# \*\*Garden Society Section\*\*

Open to any garden society including U3a groups, Springfields Daffodil Challenge individuals.

### Best Collection of Stems from Any Division & Best Exhibits 41 a, b & c

- Class 41a: Bulbs in a container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter.
- Class 41b: HGS five bulbs in a container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter.
- Class 41c: Springfields Daffodil Challenge one stem in a test tube, single hole block

### \*\*Miscellaneous Section\*\*

To be displayed in container & See Class 45a – container size as indicated.

- Class 42a: A container, 30-cm in diameter, of daffodils grown by the exhibitor.
- Class 42b: Five Stems of multi headed cut daffodils in a vase.
- Class 43a: Five tulips one variety of cut stems in a vase
- Class 43b: A container, 30-cm in diameter, of mixed variety tulips
- Class 43c: A container, 30cm in diameter, of a single variety tulip
- Class 44a: A container, 30-cm in diameter of three hyacinths
- Class 44b: A container, 30-cm in diameter of five hyacinths
- Class 45a: A container, 20-cm in diameter of single amaryllis
- Class 45b: A container, other bulbs and corms, 30-cm for one variety growing bulb flower.

### \*\*Herbaceous Plant Section\*\*

Class 46: Three different hardy cut flowers from any species or variety of herbaceous or bulbous plant (shrubs, daffodils, tulips, or narcissus excluded)

Class 47: One pot plant in flower grown in house owned by exhibitor for at least six months.

Class 48: Stems from one hardy flowering tree, shrub, or climber

Class 49: Stems from three hardy flowering trees, shrubs, or climbers. To be exhibited in separate containers. Exhibitors provide their own containers.

Class 50: A container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter of single cactus.

# \*\*Springfields Daffodil Challenge – (SDC)\*\*

### Best Exhibit Bulb Class 51 & 52 - Stem Grown Locally

Class 51: Growing bowl or pot, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter, of five bulbs from the 'Garden Giveaway'. Class 52: Growing bowl or pot, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter, of five bulbs from the 'clubs and societies.

N.B. Awards Point System: - Best Daffodil in the Show, Best Exhibit in the Show
