Division 11 (Split Corona) - cont'd

Class 19: One Bloom Perianth Yellow

Classes 20 To 25 Exhibits To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes In A Three-Hole Block

Three Multi Headed Bloom Class 20-22

- Class 20: Three multi headed blooms, any one variety, from division 5.
- Class 21: Three multi headed blooms, any one variety, from division 7.
- Class 22: Three multi headed blooms, any one variety, from division 8.

Three Single Bloom Class 23 -25

- Class 23: Three single flowered blooms from division 1, 2, 3, 4 or 11.
- Class 24: Three single flowered blooms, any one variety from division 6
- Class 25: Three single flowered blooms from division 9, 10, 12 and 13

Class 26 To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes, In A 5 Hole Block

Five Bloom Class 26

Class 26: Five single flowered blooms from any division

Classes 27 To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes In Either 1 X 6 Hole Block Or 2 X 3 Hole Block

Six Distinct Blooms Class 27

Class 27: Six distinct blooms, no more than two blooms from any division, three different divisions or more

Class 28 To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes, In A 5 Hole Block

Five Distinct Blooms Class 28

Class 28: Five blooms any one variety in a 5 hole block.

Classes 29 & 30 To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes In A 3 Hole Block

Three Distinct Blooms Class 29-30

- Class 29: Three distinct blooms, one bloom from either division 1, 2 or 3
- Class 30: Three distinct blooms, from division 4

Novice Section

To include first time exhibitors who've not previously won or been awarded 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize at a show.

To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes In A Single Hole Block

One Bloom Division 1 - 4, Class 31 - 35

- Class 31: One bloom division 1
- Class 32: One bloom division 2
- Class 33: One bloom division 3
- Class 34: One bloom division 4
- Class 35: One bloom from any division, up to four entries per exhibitor, but each entry must be from a different division.

Youth Section

Open To Any Individual, School, Society, Or Group For Young People (Under 16 Years Of Age)

To Be Displayed In Individual Test Tubes In A Single Hole Block

One Bloom Division 1 - 4, Class 36 - 40

Class 36: One bloom division 1

Class 37: One bloom division 2

Class 38: One bloom division 3

Class 39: One bloom division 4

Class 40: One bloom from any division, up to four entries per exhibitor, but each entry must be from a different division.

Best Five, Single, Art Class & Writing 41-45

Class 41: Five best daffodils in a vase (one representative entry per class only)

Class 42: Best single daffodil in a test tube (one representative entry per class only)

Class 43: Best photographs of daffodils (three representative digital entries per class only)

Class 44: Best painting of daffodils (three representative entries per class only; A3 or A4)

Class 45: Best daffodil poem

Garden Society Section

Open To Any Garden Society Including U3a Groups, Springfields Daffodil Challenge Individuals.

Best Collection of Blooms from Any Division & Best Exhibits 46 - 48

Class 46: Bulbs in a container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter.

Class 47: HGS 5 daffodils of Cheerfulness in a container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter.

Class 48: Springfields Daffodil Challenge one bloom in a test tube, single hole block

Miscellaneous Section

To Be Displayed In A Vase Or Container Of The Size Indicated In Each Class 49 to 57.

Class 49: Five Blooms of multi headed cut daffodils in a vase.

Class 50: Five tulips one variety of cut blooms in a vase

Class 51: A container, 30-cm in diameter, of daffodils grown by the exhibitor

Class 52: A container, 30-cm in diameter, of mixed variety tulips

Class 53: A container, 30cm in diameter, of a single variety tulip

Class 54: A container, 30-cm in diameter of three hyacinths

Class 55: A container, 30-cm in diameter of five hyacinths

Class 56: A container, 20-cm in diameter of single amaryllis

Class 57: A container, other bulbs and corms, 30-cm for one variety growing bulb flower.

Herbaceous Plant Section

Class 58: Three different hardy cut flowers from any species or variety of herbaceous or bulbous plant (shrubs, daffodils, tulips, or narcissus excluded) – Exhibitor to provide own container.

Class 59: One pot plant in flower grown in house owned by exhibitor for at least six months.

Class 60: Blooms from one hardy flowering tree, shrub, or climber - Exhibitor to provide own container.

Class 61: Blooms from three hardy flowering trees, shrubs, or climbers. To be exhibited in separate containers. Exhibitors provide their own containers.

Class 62: A container, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter of single cactus.

Springfields Daffodil Challenge – (SDC)

Best Exhibit Bulb Class 63 & 64 - Bloom Grown Locally

Class 63: Growing bowl or pot, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter, of five bulbs from the 'Garden Giveaway'.

Class 64: Growing bowl or pot, not exceeding 30-cm in diameter, of five bulbs from the 'clubs and societies.
