

Design Brief: Flag for Springfields Festival Gardens

Context:

Springfields Festival Gardens is a place of beauty, exploration and community spirit. It blends nature, creativity, and local heritage, making it a unique and inspiring location. We are inviting students to design a flag that captures the spirit of the Gardens which can be proudly displayed to visitors, staff and the wider community.

Design Challenge:

Create a flag that represents Springfields Festival Gardens using a maximum of four colours, one of which must be green. The design should be bold, meaningful and suitable for outdoor display.

Design Requirements:

- Colour Limit: Use a maximum of four colours, one of which must be green. In this
 context, white can be considered a colour.
- Theme: Reflect the identity of Springfields Festival Gardens nature, community and creativity
- Simplicity: The flag should be easy to recognise and be eye-catching from a distance.
- Originality: All designs must be original and created by the student
- Submission Format: Designs should be submitted on A4 paper or digitally to Education.Outreach@springfields.net

Judging Criteria:

- Visual Impact & Originality (30 points) Is it eye-catching and creative?
- Represents Garden Values (25 points) Does it connect to nature and gardens?
- Colour Use (20 points) Good use of colour palette?
- Will It Work as Planted Flowers? (15 points) Can it be made with bedding plants?
- Effort & Skill for Age (10 points) Did you try your best?
